AVERAGE TEMPERATURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summer temperature from 30s at night to upper 80s in day (degrees F) • www.weather.com • Night time temperatures can be cool and may require long sleeves or a lightweight jacket. Daytime temperatures are warm.
WHAT TO WEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring clothing for warm daytime temperatures, and a light jacket or long sleeves for some evenings.

This area is very beautiful, but very remote!!
AREA FACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See it, and you'll understand immediately why the North Rim is regarded as the Grand Canyon's "best side." While visitors at the South Rim jostle with crowds and endure daytime temperatures nearing 100°, those fortunate enough to see the Grand Canyon from it's North Rim will have a whole different experience; one the travel magazine Conde Nast once described years ago as "the Connoisseur's Grand Canyon." • Visitor facilities at the North Rim are fewer in number and smaller in scale. While the South Rim area has well over a thousand hotel rooms, the North Rim only has a couple hundred. The South Rim sees approximately five million visitors a year; the North Rim receives maybe one-tenth that number. In addition to cabins and some motel rooms, the North Rim also has a campground, restaurant, deli, cocktail lounge, gift shop and a mule trip outfitter.
